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# Long-term Care Act

Entry point

- Formal care in institution
- Formal care at home

- Center for social Work

- 5 categories:
  - (1) mild limitation of independence
  - (2) moderate limitation of independence
  - (3) severe limitation of independence
  - (4) very severe limitation of independence
  - (5) most severe limitation of independence

# Formal care at home and formal care in institutions



- Basic activities of daily living (bathing, dressing, feeding ...)
- Instrumental activities of daily living (cleaning, laundry, escort to the store...)
- Nursing care (medication administration, enteral feeding ...)



- e-care (social alarm system)
- services for strengthening and maintaining independence



physiotherapist, occupational therapist, social gerontologist,  
social worker, kinesiologist

# Cash benefit


- Monthly financial benefit for covering care expenses
- E-care
- Services for strengthening and maintaining independence

# Carer for a Family Member

- Family member living with the person they care for
- Leaves the labour market to provide care
- Receives a monthly allowance for lost income
- Entitled to paid social insurance contributions
- Eligible for 21 days of substitute/respice care
  
- E-care;

# Financing of Long-term care



# Compulsory insurance contribution

- All individuals with health insurance are also included in long-term care insurance.
- Employers: 1% of gross salary
- Employees: 1 % of gross salary
- Pensioners: 1 % of the pension
- Persons receiving financial social aid are not required to pay the contribution
- Health Insurance Institute of Slovenia
  - Collecting contributions;
  - Finances entitlements and services.
